Baiduri Capital will be implementing the two-factor authentication process for users to log in to their trading account. The primary objective of two-factor authentication (2FA) is to protect online users against unauthorised access.

Baiduri Capital Trading Account users will need:

1. (User Password) – Already in use
2. (One-time password) – New

To receive the one-time password (OTP), you will need to register your device to our system with Google authenticator as the OTP generator for your Trading Account.

## Part 1: 2FA Activation

### Step 1: Login to your Baiduri Capital Trading Account


Enter login ID and password, then Click 'Login'.

### Step 2: Choose to activate 2FA


Select 'Activate' to enable 2FA authentication for your account. You may choose to skip this step for now, but it will be compulsory to enable 2FA in the future.

#### Step 4: Start 2FA registration process


To complete the 2FA registration, you are required to link your login account to your device.

You will need to install the Google Authenticator app on your preferred device and scan the QR code to link the device and your login account.

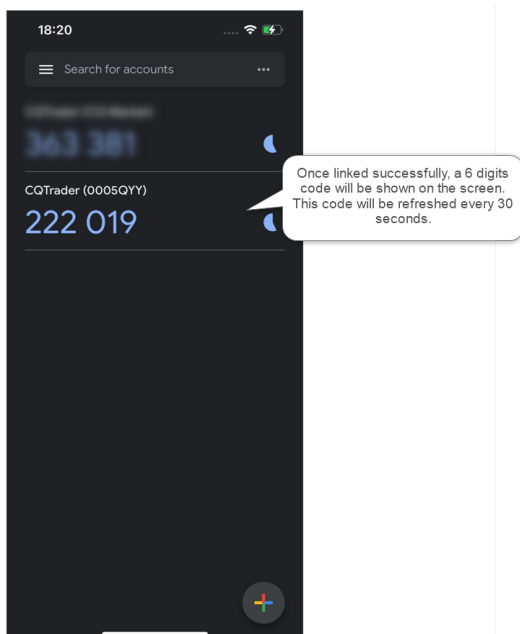
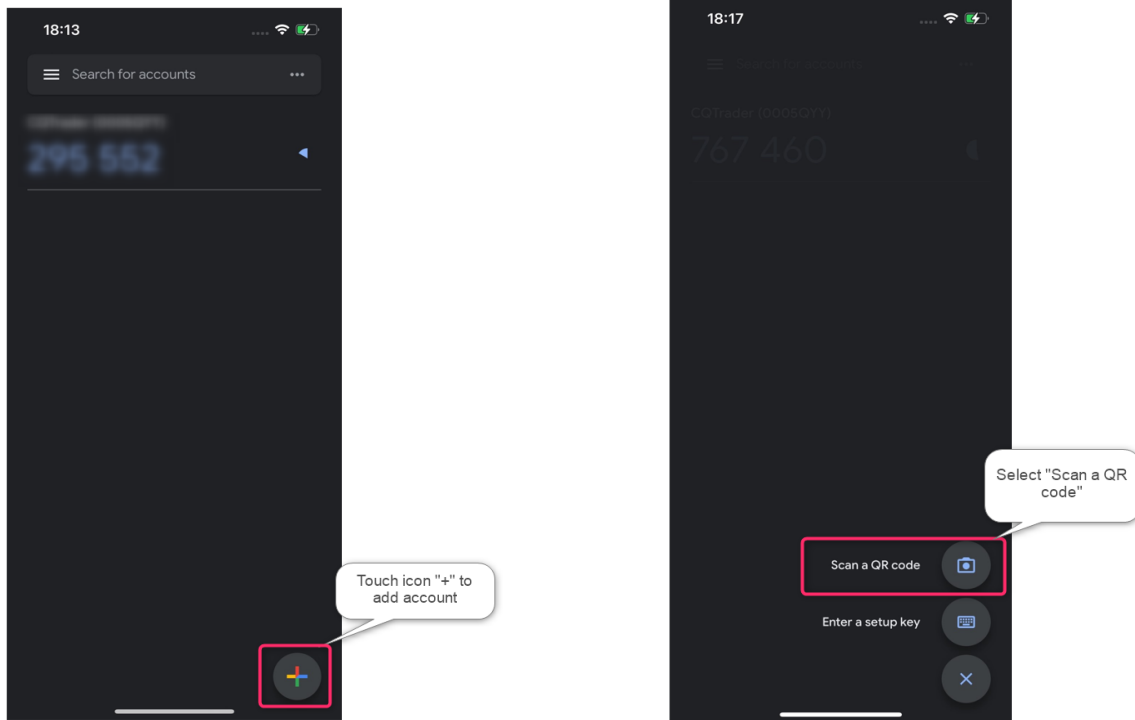

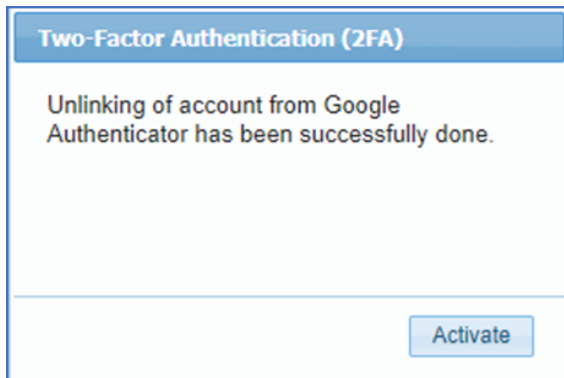
