Why invest?

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Payout at Maturity

b. Coupon

i. Guaranteed Coupon

Guaranteed coupon of 10% payable only upon maturity.

ii. Additional Coupon

Investor has the possibility to receive an Additional Coupon which depends on the performance of 5 Singapore Blue Chip companies (DBS, SingTel, CapitaLand, Keppel and Singapore Airlines).

The performance of the 5 Singapore Blue Chip companies is equal to the average of the monthly observations of each company throughout the 5 year investment horizon (Compared to the initial level recorded on April 13th 2015) and observe half of it.

The additional coupon is equal to the recorded performance of the 5 Singapore Blue Chip companies minus 10%. Additional Coupon: $[(\text{Average of monthly observations of the 5 Singapore Blue Chips companies} \div 2) - 10\%]$

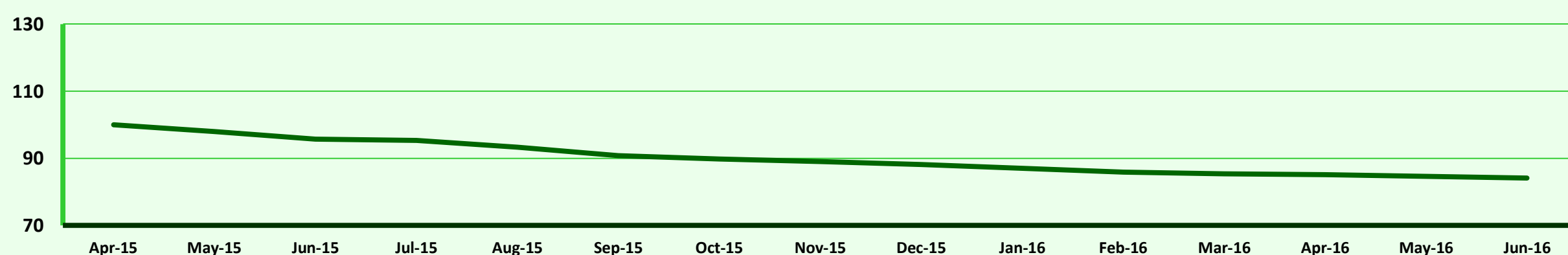

DBS (+4.89%)

DBS Group and Standard Chartered PLC have developed ledger offering a solution to the risk of multiple-invoice fraud faced by the largest trade-finance bankers. DBS also provides S\$300M loan for Eu Yan Sang privatisation.

SingTel (-0.52%)

SingTel kept at 'Buy' by Nomura with \$4.25 target price. SingTel's fourth quarter net profit of S\$946M was up 0.8% from S\$939M in the year-ago period. Mobile data was a key contributor to growth, particularly amongst the regional mobile associates, together with cloud and cyber securities services.

CapitaLand (-0.66%)

CapitaLand kept at 'buy' by Daiwa with higher \$3.96 target price. CapitaLand launches Raffles City Shenzhen featuring smart technologies and its subsidiary CapitaLand Commercial Trust to acquire remaining 60% of CapitaGreen for S\$393M.

Keppel (+5.47%)

Keppel Corp rated new hold at Deutsche Bank with \$5.90 target price. Its offshore and marine units signed a shareholders' agreement with Russian oil firm Rosneft and Norwegian drilling equipment firm, MHWirth, to establish a Singapore incorporated joint venture company.

Singapore Airlines (-3.82%)

Singapore Air cut to underweight vs overweight at Morgan Stanley. Singapore Air to form partnerships with United Airlines to forge a codeshare alliance to fend off pressure from other competitors.
